

CONDITIONS for Landor Races 2019  
Sat October 5<sup>th</sup> and Mon 7<sup>th</sup> October

1. To be run under the rules and regulations of the RWWA, Exempt CR 19(c) and AR158.
2.
  - (a) Nominations for all races close with the Handicapper [graemehammarquist@hotmail.com](mailto:graemehammarquist@hotmail.com) on September 17<sup>th</sup> 2019.
  - (b) All weights will be declared September Friday 20<sup>th</sup> 2019.
  - (c) The winner of any advertised flat race after the declaration of weights may be penalized by the handicapper or in his absence by the Steward.
  - (d) Minimum handicap weight 70kg.
3. For the Purpose of this Program:
  - a) The winner of any metropolitan race is ineligible for this meeting
  - b) A DQ horse is one that has been nominated to the Secretary in writing and be in control of the nominator six months immediately prior to the race meeting and has not started during that same six months.
  - c) An open class horse is any horse not having won on a metropolitan racecourse.
  - d) All horses starting at Landor must have trialed to the satisfaction of the stewards. Any horse may trial within the district qualifying race embargo period
  - e) All horses with an embargo, excepting gate manners, must have trialed to the satisfaction of the stewards. Any such horse may trial within the district qualifying race embargo period
4. Any horse racing at Landor can only start three times over the weekend once on one day and twice on the other day of racing.
5.
  - (a) Horses nominated for the Ladies Bracelet, must be declared as acceptors by 3.30pm on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2019.
  - (b) Horses nominated for the Landor Cup must be declared acceptors by 12.00pm on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> October 2019.
  - (c) Riders for both races must be nominated at time of acceptance, and can only be changed by permission of the steward.
6.
  - (a) Horses nominated for all other races not mentioned in Condition 5 must be declared as acceptors, to the secretary's office, no later than one hour prior to the advertised start time of each race.
  - (b) Any horse not declared an acceptor by the time stated will be automatically withdrawn.
  - (c) Open horses nominated for open races will have the first right of acceptance over DQ horses.
7. For the purpose of this program, riders:
  - (a) Must not have been licensed as a Jockey for a minimum period of at least five years prior to the race meeting.
  - (b) Any rider not eligible under section 7(a), upon nomination, can be considered and allowed to ride at the discretion of the club and the Steward.
  - (c) Must hold a current fast track work rider's license and riding regularly in this capacity.
  - (d) Any approved or amateur rider who has a riding engagement at any race meeting shall not at such race meeting make or have an interest in a bet, or be present in the betting ring.
  - (e) An amateur or approved rider who owns a horse entered in a race shall not without the permission of the Stewards accept an engagement to ride another horse in that race.
8.
  - (a) Riders must be nominated by 3pm on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2019.
  - (b) Colors, skullcaps and vest must be worn.
  - (c) All riders are insured as per RWWA policy as per Amateur and Approved Riders schedule.
9.
  - (a) The committee reserves the right to decline to receive, or at any time after having received, reject any nomination without giving reason for doing so.
  - (b) That the committee, at any time, may accept or reject any nomination of a rider.
10. Bookmakers fee \$50.
11. A maximum of ten (10) starters per race for this programme, any fields greater than ten to be approved by the steward.
12. Weekend admission- \$75 per person, 10-17 years \$15, Under 10 years free.
13. Annual membership \$90 to be paid in full by Monday 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2019
