Welcome to the 98th anniversary of the **Landor** races to be held over the weekend of the 4th of October to 7th October 2019. We hope you enjoy a truly memorable and unique weekend at one of the last true bush race meetings in Australia. Our committee is proud of the Landor tradition and are dedicated to its' survival. Here are a few bits and pieces of information for visitors new to Landor so that you can join in and have fun.

EMERGENCY CONTACTS (emergency phone numbers available at the bar)

- **Doctor** - the **MEDICAL** camp is located towards the northern end of the station camps.(along the creek)
- **Ambulance** - Located behind the police camp and will be on course during race afternoons and the gymkhana.
- **Security** - staff are on duty every evening and during race days.
- **Police** - are in attendance and located at the Police camp adjacent to the water tanks. Please be aware that drink driving rules do apply and will be enforced.
- **President** - Don Hammarquist, located at the Mt Augustus camp. **Secretary** - Sandy Wendt, located at the Milly Milly camp or at the Secretary's room in the hall during race afternoons.
- **Telephone** - A satellite phone for emergency use is available. Contact the secretary or a committee member if needed. (recognizable by the blue shirts or committee badge)

VISITOR FACILITIES

- **Admission** - Adults \$75, \$15 for 10 to under 18 and under 10's are free. You must have an admission wristband to be on course and you cannot be granted entry to the bar and hall area over the weekend without one. **Sorry, but no eftpos or credit card facility's are available**
- **Showers and toilets** - SEE NOTE BELOW sufficient facilities are situated throughout the grounds. Visiting camper facilities are situated near visitor camp grounds. Toilet paper - is a service provided which is topped up daily by the committee, if it runs short you can get more from the bar on request.
- **Water** - the course has ample supplies, but **PLEASE BE AWARE THAT WATER CANNOT BE SUPPLIED UNTILL LATE ON THE THURSDAY PRECEEDING THE RACES.**
- **Power** - there are no powered campsites.
- **Bar facilities** - the public bar is licensed and requires all patrons to display a current admission band or you will be refused service. Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult. The committee also **welcomes** any assistance and help with the bar roster over the weekend. Bar times 7pm to 12am Friday, 11 am to 1 am Saturday, 12 am to 12 pm Sunday, and 12 am to 12 pm Monday. The bar will be closed between 6 and 8 pm daily.
- **Social Calendar** - refer to the Race book for a programme of the weekend's timetable of activities.
- **Rubbish** - Bins are provided at the racecourse, camps are requested to take their rubbish to the tip on the eastern side of the Aurillia Creek.
- **Wood** - Limited wood is provided at the shower blocks, but visitors will need to collect wood for their own use. We suggest you travel at least 5km north of the racecourse or to the eastern side of the Aurillia Creek.
- **Ice** - while available, on sale daily at the bar between **9.00AM and 10.00AM and during bar hours**. Also available from Lisas cafe during breakfast hours
- **Fuel** - on sale from Tanker- **8.00am to 10.00am** Saturday, Sunday and Monday, or as advised via announcements

SAFETY

- **Vehicles** -Please keep your speed below 40km/hr around the grounds. Police and committee will monitor patron's behaviour in vehicles. No under-aged or un-licensed drivers please, no kids on back of utes and please no drink driving.
- **Horses** - Parents - please keep your kids away from horses to avoid accidents. Not all horses are as well mannered as your kids!
- **Dogs** - Please keep your dogs controlled, especially race days where dogs found wandering will be impounded.
